We have good news, friends – Intermountain recently received a \$100,000 cap-off matching gift to be used to renovate a vacant cottage into Van Orsdel Commons, a chapel on campus for our residential program in Helena!

We have until November 11, 2016, to raise the matching funds in order to receive the entire grant, and all gifts earmarked for the chapel will be matched, dollar for dollar, up to the amount needed to complete this project. To date, because of people like you, we've raised more than half of what is needed, but we're still busy asking individuals and churches to help us raise the remaining funds.

A STORY FROM THE CHAPLAIN'S PROGRAM

By this time, many children were nodding their heads. This made sense to them. They understood the walls they had placed in the way of God and others which prevented healing of their heavy and hurting hearts.

This is the kind of powerful experience you give to kids in need when you support Intermountain.

COTTAGE NAMED FOR GENEROUS SUPPORTERS LIKE YOU

Pastor Tim Lanham, recalls the Secret Santa project his small Presbyterian congregation worked on each Christmas as a frustration and a disappointment. "We wanted to have mission work that was more fulfilling," he says. "We wanted to be a partner."

The partnership between Intermountain and Sunrise Presbyterian Church was celebrated recently when one of Intermountain's new residential cottages was named Sunrise! Pastor Lanham, along with several of the 180 members of the Great Falls church, gathered with members of the Intermountain board and staff in Helena for prayers and fellowship and to watch the sun peek over the top of the new cottage bearing the Sunrise name.

Board member John Watson noted Lanham and his congregation have done a good job of using Intermountain as a primary mission of the church. Having a facility named for the church is, “a worthy honor,” Watson said, given what the small church has accomplished.

“It’s amazing,” said Intermountain Board President, Rev. Marianne Niesen. “This is what church people should be about.”

Over the last 10 years, Sunrise members have provided teddy bears, blankets, shoes, coats, Christmas gifts, and books, among other items for the children. But they have also been responsible for providing more than \$1 million for the facilities and operations of Intermountain, including funds raised through the creation of elaborate tree packages sold at the annual Festival of Trees. One of those packages included an operational 1926 Mercedes convertible kit car. That tree brought the largest single bid in the history of the event – \$62,000! But more than that, several members of the church are familiar faces at Intermountain events and as hosts bringing others to informational tours of the campus.

Two girls who live in Sunrise Cottage presented the church members with poems written by residents of the cottage and also delivered a mural created by the children. Church members said the art would be put on display in their church building.



It was a great day full of love and support, and we are so thankful for Sunrise Presbyterian and everything they do.
