

Official Raffle Rules & Guidelines

These rules govern the raffle conducted by **Intermountain** Deaconess Children's Services, a registered Montana nonprofit organization. This is a charitable raffle. By purchasing a raffle ticket, each participant agrees to the following terms.

Eligibility

1. Must be 18 years of age or older to purchase or possess a raffle ticket.
 2. Tickets may only be purchased by individuals physically located in the state of Montana at the time of purchase.
 3. The raffle is open to Montana residents and eligible visitors.

Ticket Sales

1. Raffle tickets are \$20.00 each, and an unlimited number of tickets are available.
 2. Tickets may only be purchased in Montana, in accordance with state raffle regulations. Tickets may not be purchased outside the state of Montana.
 3. Tickets will be available from December 3, 2025, at 12:00 PM through December 7, 2025, at 4:00 PM, both in person during Festival of Trees events at the Helena Civic Center and online.
 4. Tickets may be purchased with cash, check, e-check, debit card, or credit card.

Prize Information

1. To claim a prize, winners must present a valid government-issued photo ID. The name on the winning ticket must match the name on the ID; no substitutions or transfers are permitted.
 2. All prizes must be picked up from Intermountain's Development office located at 500 S Lamborn St, Helena. Shipping or delivery is not provided.
 3. Winners are responsible for transporting the prize and for any related costs (e.g., delivery, registration, taxes, etc.).
 4. A complete description and fair-market value of each prize will be published at [FOT 2025 Main Page – Intermountain](#) before sales open but no later than December 3, 2025 at 10:00 am.

Drawing & Winner Selection

1. The raffle drawing will occur on December 12, 2025, at 10:00am at 500 S. Lamborn St, Helena, MT 59601.
 2. All drawings will be video recorded to ensure transparency and fairness.
 3. Intermountain will use a random and impartial method to select the winner(s).
 4. The winner does not need to be present to win but the winner must claim the prize on or before the 10th day after notification. Days are Monday through Friday 9:00am – 4:00 pm at Intermountain's Development Office located at 500 S. Lamborn St, Helena.
 5. If a winner cannot be contacted or fails to claim the prize within the required timeframe, an alternate winner will be drawn.

Recordkeeping

As required by Montana law, Intermountain will maintain raffle records for at least 12 months, including:

- total proceeds collected
 - detailed prize description and value
 - prize source information
 - description of the random drawing method
 - winner name and address
 - documentation showing how proceeds were used for charitable purposes

Use of Proceeds

This is a charitable raffle. All raffle proceeds directly support Intermountain's mission of providing mental, behavioral, and developmental health services to children and families, or are used to purchase raffle prizes, in accordance with state law.

Intermountain will not use raffle revenue to pay administrative or operating costs of conducting the raffle.

Winner Responsibilities

1. Winners must pick up winnings from Intermountain's Development office located at 500 S Lamborn St, Helena within the timeframe identified above.
 2. Winners must present a valid government-issued photo ID. The name on the winning ticket must match the name on the ID; no substitutions or transfers are permitted.
 3. Winners are responsible for any required taxes, fees, registrations, or other associated costs.
 4. Winners may be required to complete state or federal tax forms before receiving the prize.
